

# Latest Developments in Danish Oil and Gas Law

Course in Copenhagen 12 April 2018

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We offer a one-day course on the latest developments in Danish oil and gas law, for both existing licensees and for new or future entrants.

The interactive session gives an overview of relevant oil and gas law issues as of 2018, including licensing terms, declaration of commerciality, development plans, third-party access, liability, financial security, permits, HSE, state participation and taxation as well as the regulatory authorities involved in E&P.

Sessions are rich on cases and examples. Special sessions are devoted to the Danish model license and JOA.
